



M-EcoDeck Maintenance guide for synthetic floors:

M-EcoDeck synthetic floors are seamless and very wear-resistant. These floors are designed to meet your safety requirements without compromise. To keep these floors clean, safe and durable, it is important to know how to maintain these floors. Below you will find instructions and recommendations for basic cleaning of your floor, as well as information on maintenance between cleanings. We would also like to give you some tips with which you can make optimal use of the EcoDeck systems.

First time cleaning: When cleaning the floor for the first few times, we do not recommend the use of hard, coarse and/or aggressive pads and cleaning cloths (this can cause excessive polishing of the surface). Only a hard brush and plenty of water are sufficient.

Wet cleaning:

We recommend that you clean the deck once a week with our **CLEANER** for regular maintenance. This keeps the floor safe and hygienic.

To clean your deck, use the following mixing ratio: 1 part **CLEANER** to 100 parts water (1: 100). For example 10 ml **CLEANER** to 1 liter of water. However, if you have the impression that after using this mixing ratio the floor could also be cleaned with a lower concentration, you can adjust the mixing ratio to 1 part **CLEANER** to 200 parts water. The correct concentration is determined by the use, the cleaning frequency, the type of brush and the age of the floor.

The actual cleaning of the floor can be done manually or by machine. If you opt for manual cleaning, it is important that you do not allow the dirty water to soak in after mopping the floor. During drying, the dirt is drawn into the sanding groove, making the floor more soiled instead of cleaner. You can use a vacuumcleaner or an absorbent microfiber cloth to remove the dirty water.

We recommend that you keep your floor clean to ensure that the surface remains hygienic and clean. If the deck is more dirty than normal, let the cleaning product work for a little longer (max. 10 min. and of course without it drying!). This gives the dirt time to loose and will make it easier to remove. If not everything is collected when removing the dirty water, you can decide to scrub the floor again or slightly increase the concentration of the cleaning product in the water the next time you clean the floor. In case of serious pollution or overdue maintenance, the floor can be cleaned with **STRIPPER**. This is a highly effective cleaner based on a higher concentration (1:50 to 1:100). When using **STRIPPER**, the same rules apply as for the regular **CLEANER**.
In this case it is important to scrub the floor again with clear, clean water afterwards.

Recommendations:

- Use a cotton or microfibre duster every day.
- Cleaning once a week* with our **CLEANER**. This means first covering the deck with the product (mixing ratio of 10ml **cleaner** to 1L water), letting the product do its work (max. 10 minutes) and then mopping/scrubbing and vacuuming. Rinse well!
Don't let it dry out.
- Clean once a month* with **STRIPPER**. This means first covering the deck with the product (mixing ratio of 10ml **cleaner** to 1L water), letting the product do its work (max. 10 minutes) and then mopping/scrubbing and vacuuming. Rinse well!
Do not let it dry.

Extra protection:

- Every six months* after cleaning with **CLEANER** and rinsing frequently with water and after the deck has completely dried, you can apply the **NANO-Coating** with a microfiber cloth. A premium and durable coating, which protects your deck against the elements.

* this time schedule is highly dependent on the intensity of use.

Dry cleaning:

If your floor is used intensively, signs of use will remain. Examples are dust, sand, etc. These signs of use can cause scratches in your floor and 'worn' spots. To prevent damage as much as possible, we recommend that you keep your floor clean. We recommend using a synthetic cloth. The static effect of the cloths ensures that dust adheres to the mop and does not leave any dirt behind.

PAY ATTENTION:

When purchasing synthetic and dust-binding cloths, we recommend:

- Purchase of products that do not contain oil-based materials.
- Wash your cloths regularly to maintain the static effect.
